


WEST COAST WANDERINGS

What a background for the nation's oldest sprint car association to open their 40th season.

The California Racing Association hits the road for Imperial for their traditional opening weekend at the California Mid-Winter Fair. It will be the 29th year at the fair for the Southern California sprint cars, oldest sprint car race at a State Fair in the country.

Running on the 3/8 mile dirt oval, in front of a huge grandstand at the Imperial County Fairgrounds, with the busy Fair and carnival as a backdrop, the two race Sat. and Sun. March 2nd and 3rd events will be CRA's only day time races of the season.

For many of the fans in the Southeast area of California embracing the cities of El Centro, Imperial and Brawley, located on the Mexico and Arizona borders, it is their Indy 500, the one racing event of the year to see open wheel sprinters.

The history of racing at the Imperial County Fairgrounds is second to none in the country for tracks still running sprint cars. The track started out as a mile dirt oval in the early 1930's in AAA's Pacific Southwest Circuit which included Ascot and San Jose's banked 5/8 mile ovals, the Banning half mile and miles at Phoenix, Fresno, Bakerfield and Oakland.

A few stand out drivers of that era that ran well on the Fairgrounds at Imperial were Ernie Triplett, Al Gordon and Rex Mays. Tragically, Triplett died in a fatal crash on Imperial's mile in 1934, ending the career of one of autoracing's first big stars.

From the mile dirt with the Indy drivers, the track became a half-mile oval with spring cars or Big Cars as they were known in the early days, taking over. Last year the half mile was shortened to a 3/8 mile dirt oval.

This year will mark the 63rd and 64th races that started back on March 3, and 4, 1956 with Billy Garret in the C&T Automotive Ardun and Jack Gardner in his own Mercury the first two winners. Since then, victory circle has looked like a who's who in sprint car racing. Feature winners included Art Bisch, Colby Scroggin, Billy Cantrell, Buzz Rose, Jim Hurtubise, Parnelli Jones, Jim McElreath, Gordon Woolley, Bob Hogle, Dick Fries, Don Thomas, Jimmy Oskie, Jerry McClung, Don Hawley, Paul Jones, Gary Ponzini, Don Hamilton, Frank McDaniel, Buddy Taylor, Dean Thompson, Bobby Olivero, Clark Templeman Jr., Ron Shuman, Buster Venard, Mike Sweeney, Lealand McSpadden, Jay East, Wayne Bennet, Al Unser Jr., Bubby Jones and Chuck Gurney.

Hogle is "King of the Roost" with five feature wins followed by Scroggins, Cantrell, Hurtubise, Woolley, Templeman and Gurney with three victories. Leading the car owners in wins is Alex Morales with nine features and Bruce Bromme with four.

Winning engines on the tough dirt oval look like this. Chevys or variations 43, Offys 14, Arduns and Mercurys two and Dodge one. When was the last time a non-Chevy won? It was on March 4, 1972 when Don Hamilton brought home the Morales "Tamale Wagon" with an Offy.

Drivers who swept both ends of the two day affairs are Chuck Gurney, Jim Hurtubise, Gordon Woolley, Clark Templeman, Ron Shuman and Bob Hogle.

Last year's 20 lap feature winners were Mike Sweeney and Eddie Wirth with Wirth being crowned "King of the Fair" with the most points in the two complete shows.

Brand new 3/8 mile track records are: One lap 18.019 by Dean Thompson in the Bromme Donovan. Three laps Billy Boat in the Chumbley Chevy 56.691, six laps Jim Eiland in the Woodland Chevy 2:02.26, ten laps 3:07.33 by Chuck Gurney in the Gibson Chevy and twelve lap mark of 3:43.83 by Gary Howard in the Kasparoff Donovan. All these marks set last year in CRA's first time out on the 3/8's. Look for an assault on the new records this year.

Whether you fly, drive, walk or whatever don't miss this event. It's a throwback to the old IMCA mid-west State Fair circuit of years past.

I will be doing the announcing so drop by and say hello and let's enjoy some top racing.
